Northbrook School District 27 is pleased to present its 2009 Summer School Program schedule. This year's program provides students with the option to select from a wide variety of four-week courses that will be held from 9:00 a.m. - 10:25 a.m. and from 10:30 a.m. - 12:00 noon. Classes will begin on Wednesday, June 10 and end on Friday, July 3, 2009.

A fee of \$90 will be charged per class for students residing in School District 27. **Students residing outside of District 27 will be charged \$100 per class.** Several classes require an additional fee. When applicable, these fees are listed with the class description.

Registrations for the Summer Program must be postmarked no later than Friday, **March 27, 2009.** A late registration charge of \$15 per class will be assessed after the 27th. Classes are filled on a first-come-first-serve basis. **Unless noted differently in the class description, all classes have a minimum enrollment of 10 and a maximum enrollment of 18 students.** Please complete one registration form for each child, and enclose a check or money order payable to School District 27. There will be no refunds given after April 27, 2009.

## DESIGNS TO WEAR

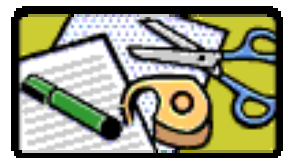

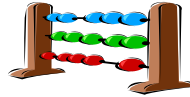

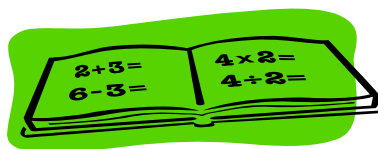
