

MEETINGS: PROCEDURES: PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

The Board of Education welcomes attendance by members of the public and the school staff at its meetings.

At appropriate times, the president may invite comments by visitors to the meeting, or may give an opportunity for a public presentation when permission is requested in advance to do so. The persons wishing to be heard by the Board shall first be recognized by the president, shall then identify themselves and proceed with their comments as briefly as the subject permits.

The president is responsible for the orderly conduct of the meeting and shall rule on such matters as the time to be allowed for public discussion and the appropriateness of the remarks to the subject under consideration.
