Administrative Reports

Dr. Deiter, Superintendent

- Thanks to the PTA for their continued support. They have received 40 to 50 applicants for the Rohrabaugh scholarship already.
- The district is heading into a hiring season. They are going to be looking to fill Dr. Fournier's position (which will be made a Director position) and to fill the Director of Special Education position (which will be a full time position). They will also be looking for a replacement for Meggan Buchanan who will be accepting a job as a principal in District 300.
- As far as covid restrictions, the district has been mask optional for 2 weeks, and it seems to be going well. Dr. Deiter estimates that 30 to 50% or more of students are wearing masks in the classes. They are still waiting on guidance from the state on physical spacing and any other updates. The goal would be for a more normal end of school year environment and to hopefully start the next year without too many covid measures in place.

Dr. Fournier, Assistant Superintendent for Personnel and Student Services

- The update about Mrs. Buchanan's position will be in the board news on Friday. Mrs. Buchanan's role will continue to be split between Hickory Point (40%) and Shabonee (60%).
- The district has already hired one new hire for next year the Orchestra Director replacement.
 They are hiring Nathan Rhodes, who has experience at a charter school as well as Highland Park District 112.

Dr. Olson, Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment

 with a crown and ribbons.

- Academically, full intervention and supports are in place at Hickory Point. There are also more
 opportunities to do small group instruction.
- And finally, thanks to the PTA for the hot lunch program, everyone looks forward to it each week.

Emily Taylor, President

- Emily will be scheduling a meeting after spring break with the PTA Presidents and Treasurers
 regarding taxes for hot lunch. They are testing out a potential solution at Wood Oaks with the
 Illinois Department of Revenue. Update from Debbie, Karen received a letter that the forms they
 submit are missing a social security number. Karen has been calling the Illinois Department of
 Revenue to talk to them about it.
- Has anyone had a chance to talk to Robin Bear about having vendors pay sales tax instead of us? Emily responded that Robin said that the vendors do not want to do that.
- We may need to look at a new hot lunch vendor for next year if we cannot resolve the social security number issue.
- The next reporting is due April 20th. We should be bringing the new people on the slates at each PTA in on these meetings so they are aware of what has transpired. At the same meeting we should also have the Treasurer's talk about how to streamline their process across all of the PTAs.

Hickory Point – Samantha Diamond and Kate Riggs

- On Friday they will be having a big teacher luncheon with surprises all of this is going to be funded by the large doughnut fundraiser sale held in December.

- They are also filling co-chair positions, planning for a family night, and working on Teacher Appreciation Week plan.

Shabonee - Lynn Howard

Wood Oaks - Debbie Salzer Rothschild and Rivka Daar

- Wood Oaks has an upcoming Dine Out at the Claim Company after spring break on 3/30 and 3/31 and will be receiving 20% back.
- The AmazonSmile issues have been remedied thanks to past PTA Presidents for helping resolve that now everything at Wood Oaks goes through the Chase account.
- On St Patrick's Day, Erin Machat and Debbie Salzer Rothschild have planned goodies for the staff.
- They are asking students to bring back summer reading books that are laying around the house, with hopes to reuse and hand out to students. The PTA will base their order on the number of returned books. Wood Oaks has agreed to let the PTA collect books for the book swap so that supplies can be refreshed.
- The 3 PTAs have coordinated with the district for a teacher appreciation gift in May.
- And they will be having a graduation party for the 8th graders. The first meeting happens today.
 Traditionally this is held at WhirlyBall and it is normally the Monday after graduation but this year that will be Memorial Day, so it may be on a Tuesday.
- Question about summer reading books: Can Shabonee do the same and request old summer reading books back and reuse them? Last year the school purchased the books instead of the PTA, but we can certainly collect them. There are numbers of those books returned each year at the book swap. Perhaps we can ask to collect them as part of the upcoming book swap. Just note in the past some of those books that have been returned were likely donated to Bernie's and will not be found at the school.

New Business:

- At the holidays, there is a staff appreciation collection that has typically been done outside the PTA; however this year, Hickory Point and Shabonee both used the PTA Zelle account to receive electronic payments. Should this be a PTA function or not? Would this money collection count as a fundraiser? We need to look into this further. Per Emily, in the past this was never a PTA collection it comes from the parents. Even though we now can receive electronic payments at the PTA, we may need to put restrictions around when we do.
- Debbie is aware of a collection for Ukraine, it has been posted on Facebook. There are three
 ladies in the district who are collecting items. Would the district allow us to put donation boxes in
 the schools after Spring Break? Dr. Deiter thinks we could add a donation box, but he will just

defer to the principals about where. We can add to the PTA blogs in the newsletters and do any blast as well.
