1. Welcome

The meeting began at 9:20.

2. Principal Report

Dr. McElligott reported:

- a. Wood Oaks had busy weekend. The musicians participated in IGSMA. The staff was pleased and the groups scored high. The band performance was moved to Friday night as many students were going to the regional science fair on Saturday. Science fair results: 18 students participated, 12 gold and 11 qualified for State, 5 silver and 1 bronze. Several students also won individual awards.
- b. On March 10, the Eighth Graders will hear Carl Wilkens speak. This is Mr. Wilken's 9th year speaking to students at Wood Oaks. He was the last American to stay in Rwanda during the genocide. He is personally responsible for saving hundreds of lives. He will spend the afternoon with the students. He is an excellent speaker and this is an amazing learning opportunity for the students.
- c. The Illinois science assessment will take place this week for Eighth Graders only. The Sixth and Seventh Grade staff have organized things for the other students to do. Only the IAR tests remain. ELA one week and math the next week. Star testing in May will be taken during a math test.
- d. Four Vex robotics teams are going to State. Five qualified. He next step is the world competition. A couple of teams have a chance at reaching the competition in Louisville.
- e. There are two more weeks in the quarter. The staff/student volleyball game will take place the Friday afternoon before Spring Break.
- f. The school musical will take place after Spring Break. There are two separate casts this year for The Little Mermaid. There are normally 5 shows, but this year there will be 6. The shows will be Wednesday and Thursday night, both 2 p.m., and 5 p.m. on Saturday. There will be two shows during the school day, so each cast/crew has the opportunity to participate in three shows. The Fifth Graders will join the Sixth Graders to see the show. The Seventh and Eighth Graders will see it together.
